- 7. Classes may be divided if crowded conditions exist in the ring.
- 8. Exhibitors are responsible for getting their animal to the ring on time.

Two Calls per individual in a class will be all that will be called.

After that, the class will be closed and judging will begin.

- 9. Judge's decision will be final and prizes will be awarded accordingly.
- 10. All breeding animals will be required to have registration papers at check-in. Ear tattoos may be compared to registration papers. All questionable steers will show as crossbreds or as determined by ethics committee.
- 11. Any exception to the entry rules must be approved by the Show Committee. The Show Committee reserves the right to make any changes or exceptions necessary for the betterment of the show. All committee decisions are final.
