- Indiana residents (ages 8 through age 21) are eligible to show.
- All steers will be shown by breed.
- Commercial heifers will be shown by weight.
- **Purebred Heifers and Steers must have registration papers.**
- **All cattle must have a Premise ID.**
- Purebred Heifer Classes Offered: Jr. Yearling (Jan. 1 thru Apr. 30, 2009)
Summer Yearling (May 1 thru Aug. 31, 2009)
Sr. Calf (Sept. 1 thru Dec. 31, 2009)
- Class size will not exceed 10 head.
- All cattle must be shown natural: No powders, artificial tailheads or leg hair, tail switches, or cosmetic alterations. **All violators will be disqualified.**
- Cattle may arrive any time **after 7:00 a.m.** Saturday, June 12, 2010.
- Weighing of steers and commercial heifers will start at 8:00 a.m. Saturday and will weigh till 10:30 a.m.
- Show officials reserve the right to place any animal in the class which in their opinion it belongs. In any case of breed discrepancy the **COMMITTEE'S DECISION IS FINAL.**
- A protest of eligibility must be accompanied by a \$100 non-refundable fee at least one (1) hour prior to the start of the show.
- Cattle breeds include: Angus, Chianina, Hereford (Horned and Polled), Maine-Anjou, Shorthorn, Simmental, All Other Breeds (AOB) and Crossbred.
- No artificial filling of cattle will be allowed on the fairgrounds. No pumps will be allowed on the fairgrounds. Violation of this rule will result in expulsion from this show.
- **NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ACCIDENTS, THEFTS, OR LOSSES.**
- **NO ALCOHOL ON THE FAIRGROUNDS.**
- A \$25 deposit will be charged to stall outside the barn. This will be returned (if the area is cleared of straw and debris) following inspection by the committee.
- Generators encouraged. The barn has bark bedding. **NO STRAW IN THE BARN.**
