2012 NWMSU Block and Bridle Heifer and Steer Show and Schedule

- This show is open to all exhibitors who are 21 years of age and under as of January 1, 2012.
- **ALL ANIMALS MUST BE OWNED AND SHOWN BY THE EXHIBITOR!**
- All heifers must be born between September 1, 2010, and October 1, 2011, and all market animals must have been born in 2011.
- There must be 5 head of the breed of the same sex; otherwise you will be put in the A.O.B. class.
- All heifer classes will be determined by breed and age. Steers will be shown by their breed and weight. Market heifers will be shown by weight.
- There will be NO re-weighs after weigh-in. All weights are final.
- Registration papers must be present the day of show to show in the particular breed. NO copies.
- **Judges decision is final.**
- Showmanship contest will be held at the end of the show. Contestants must have shown in the show that day to be eligible.
- NO hemp, hair, or hair-like materials or surgical alterations will be permitted.
- NWMSU Block and Bridle and Harrison County are NOT responsible for ANY accidents.
- NO straw is allowed. Use shavings please.
- Show management reserves the right to interpret all rules and make any decision in the best interest of the event.
